## Boots on Your Ground Program

For payment of just \$50, you can have a forester spend two hours walking your woodland with you.

During the visit, you can ask questions, discuss plans and ask for recommendations.

<p><b>Details:</b> MFA will call you to arrange an appointment for your visit. This will be for a two-hour visit with a forester. The time can be spent at your kitchen table discussing your plans and questions, or out touring the land or a combination of both. To make the most of your time with the forester, you should have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A copy of your management plan if you have one.</li> <li>• Aerial photos of your land if you have any.</li> <li>• Any future plans you have for your land and any questions you'd like to ask the forester.</li> </ul>			
<b>Your Cost</b>			
Your share of the cost of this visit is \$50, which should be included with this application and sent to MFA at the address above. While a lot can be accomplished in two hours, you can purchase more time during the visit at \$50 per hour which would be billed by MFA. If you want a new or updated Management Plan, there would be an extra charge. Ask the forester during your visit. They can either do it for you or refer you to someone else.			
<b>After the Visit</b>			
For follow-up questions after the visit, MFA members can call the Forester Phone Line which is a free service. Others should call the forester who did the visit and expect to pay for the forester's time at the rate of \$50 per hour.
